PRIVACY POLICY

Welcome to www.idex.mptportal.com (the “Site”), a website portal provided by IDEX MPT Inc., a Delaware corporation, (“MPT”) on behalf of MPT d/b/a Fitzpatrick Company, Quadro Engineering Corp., an Ontario corporation, and Microfluidics Corporation, a Delaware corporation, (individually an “MPT Affiliate”). MPT respects your privacy, and this policy covers MPT’s handling of information collected from you through the Site.

1. Personal Information

In this policy, (a) “personal information” means any information that relates to an individual and that identifies, or can be used in conjunction with other reasonably available information to identify, such individual and (b) “non-personal information” means any information that is not personal information. You are responsible for obtaining any approvals, authorizations, consents and permissions that are required in connection with your providing MPT with any information (including, but not limited to, any personal information or non-personal information of a third party).

2. Acceptance

You should review this policy carefully, and be sure you understand it, prior to using the Site. Your use of the Site is deemed to be irrevocable acceptance by you of this policy. If you do not agree to this policy, you should not use, and should immediately terminate your use of, the Site. For purposes of this policy, accessing the Site only to review this policy is not deemed to be use of the Site.

3. Data Collected

MPT may collect from you personal information (including, but not limited to, name, e-mail address, mailing address and phone number) and non-personal information through the Site

(collectively “Collected Data”). No Collected Data is obtained from you, unless it is voluntarily provided, except for any Collected Data obtained automatically through the Site as set forth in this policy. Regardless of the method used to obtain Collected Data, MPT will retain Collected Data in its primary and backup files only to an extent that is consistent with the purposes for which it was provided and for MPT’s other legitimate business purposes (including, but not limited to, marketing).

You may refuse to provide personal information or non-personal information to MPT at any time. If you refuse to provide personal information or non-personal information when requested to do so by MPT or the Site, you may not be able to access, or otherwise enjoy the benefits of, certain features of the Site.

4. **Controller**

All Collected Data is controlled by MPT through third-party servers, or servers of MPT, located at off-site data centers. All complaints, questions and requests for additional information regarding MPT’s handling of such Collected Data, or otherwise relating to this policy, should be promptly sent to MPT as set forth in Section 17.

5. **Compliance**

MPT will comply with all laws relating to Collected Data (including, but not limited to, the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act) that are applicable to MPT. Without limiting the generality of the immediately preceding sentence, while the Site is not intended for children, if a parent or guardian of a minor who is under 13 years of age discovers that the minor’s personal information has been submitted to MPT through the Site without the parent’s or guardian's consent, MPT will use commercially reasonable efforts to remove such personal information from the Site and MPT’s servers at the parent’s or guardian's request. To request the removal of personal information of a minor who is under 13 years of age, a parent or guardian must contact

MPT as set forth in Section 17, and provide all information requested by MPT to assist it in identifying the information to be so removed.

6. **Analytical Data**

Collected Data may include certain analytical information automatically obtained by MPT, either directly or through a third party acting on its behalf, by using cookies and log files when you use the Site (including, but not limited to, a computer's access date and time, browser, connection speed, Internet protocol address, Internet service provider, language, location, manufacturer, activities while on the Site, and operating system), which does not personally identify an individual. "Cookies" are code placed on your computer by the Site that enable the Site to, among other things, (a) recognize your computer as a prior user of the Site, and (b) provide the Site with details of your prior use, whereas "log files" are files that record events occurring on MPT's (or its third-party vendor's) servers. Your browser may provide you with the ability to not accept cookies, as well as the ability to delete already-existing cookies. If you refuse, or delete previously-existing, cookies from the Site, you may not be able to enjoy some of the Site's features.

7. **Electronic Communications**

If you send MPT an e-mail message in connection with your use of the Site or in the ordinary course of business, Collected Data includes your e-mail address and the contents of your message. Whether or not you have previously sent MPT an e-mail message, you consent to MPT's sending you e-mail messages and other electronic communications (a) in connection with your use of the Site, (b) in the ordinary course of MPT's business, or (c) for any other legitimate business purpose (including, but not limited to, marketing). Since MPT endeavors to send e-mail messages and other electronic communications only to individuals desiring to receive them, you can unsubscribe to such e-mail messages or other electronic communications at any time by contacting MPT as set forth in Section 17, or if applicable, by following the directions contained in such e-mail messages or other electronic communications.

8. **Protection**

MPT will use commercially reasonable efforts to protect all personal information included within Collected Data from unauthorized access, disclosure and use, except that MPT will have no responsibility for protecting any personal information posted by you on the Site that may be accessible to the general public. For example, if you participate in any public forum on the Site, any personal information disclosed by you when doing so will be available to the general public. Also, since no transmission of information over the Internet or electronic storage of information is completely secure, it is possible that personal information included within Collected Data could be accessed, disclosed or used without authorization, even if MPT uses such reasonable efforts. In providing personal information to MPT, you must assume the risk that unauthorized access, disclosure and use of such information could occur, and if it does, MPT will not have any liability to you therefor so long as it has used such reasonable efforts.

9. **Authorized Use and Disclosure**

Subject to Section 8, all Collected Data may be used by MPT for any legitimate business purpose of MPT or any MPT Affiliate (including, but not limited to, marketing), unless expressly stated otherwise in this policy. If MPT expressly states in writing that any Collected Data will only be used for a specific purpose, MPT will only use it for such purpose, unless you subsequently consent to its being used for another purpose.

All Collected Data (including, but not limited to, personal information) obtained by MPT, whether or not for a specific purpose, may be disclosed to third parties retained by MPT (including, but not limited to, distributors, sub-contractors and vendors of MPT) for any purposes for which MPT could use such Collected Data. While any Collected Data is in the possession of such third parties, MPT will be responsible for such third parties' disclosing and using such Collected Data information in accordance with this policy.

MPT may also at any time, in its sole discretion, disclose and use any Collected Data (including, but not limited to, personal information), whether or not you furnished such Collected Data for a specific purpose, to (a) comply with, or as permitted by, any applicable law, (b) respond to any government request, (c) cooperate with law enforcement, and other third parties, in investigating a claim of fraud, illegal activity or infringement of intellectual property rights, (d) protect the rights, property or legitimate business interests of MPT or a third party, or (e) transfer such Collected Data to a third party purchasing all, or substantially all, of MPT's assets.

10. **Third-Party Sites**

The Site may contain links to, or be accessible from, websites provided by third parties (individually a "Third-Party Site"). Your use of a Third-Party Site will be subject to its terms of use and other provisions, and you are solely responsible for complying with such terms and other provisions. This policy does not cover the privacy policies or practices of any Third-Party Site, and MPT is not responsible for any information you submit to, or otherwise collected by, any Third-Party Site. MPT is only responsible for Collected Data obtained by it through your authorized use of the Site or other sources in the ordinary course of its business. You should consult each Third-Party Site for its privacy policy or practice before submitting any information to, or otherwise using, such Third-Party Site.

11. **Access**

You are solely responsible for the accuracy and completeness of all Collected Data furnished by you, and MPT does not warrant or represent that any Collected Data will be accurate or complete. Upon your request, you will be granted access to your personal information in the possession, or under the control, of MPT solely for the purpose of correcting or deleting any such information that is inaccurate or incomplete, except where the burden of providing such access would be disproportionate to the risks to your privacy or where the rights of a third party would be violated. In order to gain such access, you must contact MPT in writing as set forth in Section 17.

12. **Applicable Law**

This policy shall be governed by, and construed and interpreted in accordance with, the laws of the Illinois, without regard to principles of conflict of laws.

13. **Complaints**

Any complaint by you regarding any Collected Data or otherwise relating to this policy must first be submitted to MPT as set forth in Section 17, and MPT must be given a reasonable opportunity of not less than 60 days to investigate and respond to your complaint. Upon MPT's completing such investigation and so responding, MPT and you must then attempt, in good faith, to promptly resolve any remaining aspects of your complaint. If any aspect of your complaint remains unresolved after a reasonable period of time, and you desire to pursue other remedies, you may commence litigation against MPT in connection with the unresolved portion of your complaint only in a court located in the county of Dupage, Illinois, and having subject matter jurisdiction over your complaint. You consent to any such court's being, and waive any objection (including, but not limited to, any such objection based on inconvenience) to such court's not being, a proper venue for your complaint.

14. **Entire Agreement**

Except as set forth in this Section, this policy contains the entire agreement, and supersedes all prior oral and written agreements, proposals and understandings, between you and MPT with respect to Collected Data. If you use the Site or otherwise have business dealings with MPT, such use or dealings will be subject to this policy, plus any other written agreement between the parties that is applicable thereto (including, but not limited, any applicable terms of use). To the extent there is any conflict or inconsistency between any provision of this policy and any provision of such other agreement, the former shall control.

15. **Severability**

Whenever possible, each provision of this policy shall be interpreted to be effective and valid under applicable law. If, however, any such provision shall be prohibited by, or invalid under, such law, it shall be deemed modified to conform to the minimum requirements of such law, or if for any reason it is not so modified, it shall be prohibited or invalid only to the extent of such prohibition or invalidity without the remainder of such provision, or any other provision of this policy, being prohibited or invalid.

16. **Revisions**

MPT may revise any provision of this policy from time to time by posting the revised provision on the Site. Any such revision will take effect immediately upon such posting, and will apply to all Collected Data obtained by MPT after such posting. It is your responsibility to periodically check this policy on the Site for revisions to this policy.
